Preference will be given to candidates with a completed Ph.D. We are looking to fill a position for our new Applied Forensic Psychology Program. This new 4-year Direct Entry program is designed to prepare students for further studies or employment in various fields – clinical, counselling, social work, law, policing, corrections - through classroom-based instruction and training, as well as experiential learning via field trips and practicum placements. Core courses include: PSYC 110 Forensic Psychology and PSYC 257 Professional Skills and Practicum Training. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to the coordination and placement of practicum students. This position is subject to final budgetary approval.

The Department is seeking candidates who are committed to contributing to StFX's priorities of equity, diversity, and inclusion. A demonstrated ability in fostering a climate of inclusion in the classroom is an asset.
